

ARTIST'S STATEMENT


It is my honor and privilege to present the design for the temporary wall exhibit commemorating the 250th Birthday of the United States Marine Corps to be installed Spring 2025 in the Apex Corridors 1 & 2 at the Pentagon, Washington, DC.

The vision for the entire exhibit, which encompasses over 600 square feet of wall space on six surfaces and over 150 images, encapsulates the essence of the United States Marine Corps; not as an historical timeline, but as a collection that best represents the Spirit of Semper Fi from 1775 to 2025.












